#### 01 \_ POSTMODERNISM

# Postmodern argues that there are no overarching stories that give meaning to life or absolute truth.

It is our cultural norm to reject any overarching meta-narrative and yet our primary identity as citizens of the Kingdom of God are defined by the story of God outlined in the biblical meta-narrative.

Every system of thought begins with some ultimate principle or meta-narrative. If it doesn't begin with God, it will begin with some dimension of creation – the material, spiritual, biological, philosophical, empirical, etc.

#### Platonic Dualism

The material world is the realm of error and illusion and the path to true knowledge is to free ourselves from the bodily senses, so that reason can inform us to what is true.

#### The Romantic Era

The individual is at his most authentic before he is shaped and corrupted by the need to conform to social conventions.

## The Enlightenment

Kant – Autonomy; overthrowing all external authority which is oppressive in order to find the true inner self with is free and autonomous.

Descartes – A sharp dichotomy between matter and mind and helped usher in the concept of secular dualism

#### Social Imaginary

The myriad beliefs, practices, normative expectations, and even implicit assumptions that members of a society share and that shape their daily lives. It is the way people think about the word, how they imagine it to be, how they act intuitively in relation to it.

Each of us finds our meaning by giving expression to our own feelings and desires.

### **Moral Relativism**

\_ Will this make me happy? Does it harm someone else? Does it coincide with my deepest psychological desires and longings? Does it feel right?

Do I believe in my heart that this is right and authentic for me?

\_ Ethics, therefore, becomes a function of feeling. Ethics are built upon a subjective, emotional foundation.

# 02

Focus on an intense emotional conversion experience and even conversion at the expense of discipleship



# 03

Instituted a celebrity model of leadership with a focus on the preacher / speaker / influencer / entertainer

There was a deep suspicion of theological learning and a sort of anti-intellectualism that pervaded the church

People began focus on needs / preferences of the individual over the community and the idea that individual choice was the final determinant of belief



# 06

There was a growing tendency to ignore the historical traditions of the church: anti-creedal, anti-historical, etc.

# 07

The church withdrew from intellectual encounters with the secular world and gave up the idea that Christianity gives a comprehensive framework to interpret all of life and scholarship.



## Postmodern Evangelicalism

Postmodernism, relentlessly undermining foundations of meaning, creates an inner emptiness, an inner life in constant need of repair, and salvation. This has fused with Evangelical Christianity and resulted in the rise of "Christianity as lifestyle management."

# Throw Off All Authority


Escape from these external restrictions in order to discover our inner self, which is good and can guide us.

# Postmodern-Shaped Sexuality Hyper-Individualism In a Hyper-Sexualized Culture



#### 03 \_ POSTMODERN-SHAPED SEXUALITY



The moral structure of our society regards traditional sexual codes as oppressive and life denying and places a premium on the individual's right to define his or her existence.

# Criticism of homosexuality is now homophobia. Criticism of transgenderism is now transphobia.




